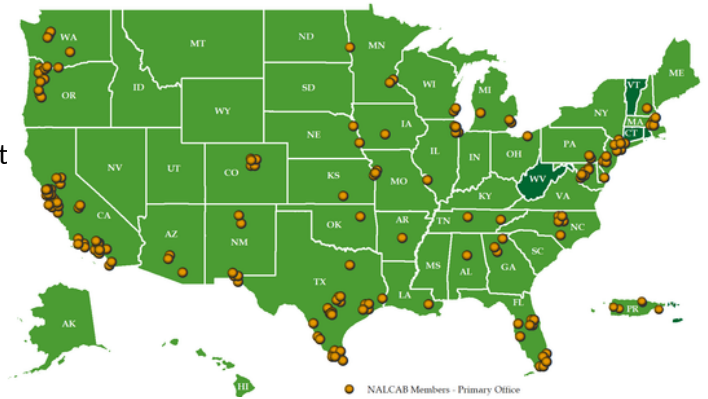
## Who We Are

### Small Business Development

NALCAB network members open doors for Latino entrepreneurs looking to start or grow their businesses. We offer access to funding, coaching and the creation of commercial districts, incubators and mercados.



### Financial Capability

We help Latino families and businesses meet their financial goals. NALCAB's network of trusted nonprofits provide financial coaching and access to affordable products that help build savings, credit and generational wealth.



### Equitable Neighborhood Development

NALCAB helps members build and maintain neighborhoods where all can thrive. We ensure that development is community-driven and responsive to the needs and aspirations of all residents, particularly the most vulnerable.



### Public Policy Advocacy

NALCAB is actively involved in research, advocacy and national partnerships to raise the profiles of key issues in our communities.

We engage policy makers to influence legislation that ensures equity of opportunity for all.



### Lending & Impact Investing

As a US Treasury-certified CDFI, NALCAB lends to nonprofit lenders and affordable housing providers. We also engage in social impact investing and offer small business loan guarantees to member lenders. Our new **NALCE** initiative unites and amplifies the voices of Latino-led CDFIs.



### Leadership Development & Technical Training

NALCAB offers a comprehensive slate of community development training through webinars and our national conference. We also offer professional development for Latino leaders through our annual **Pete Garcia Fellowship program**, and the new **Latino Executive Advancement & Development (LEAD)** program.

# Special Initiatives



## Rural Capacity Building (RCB)

Since 2013, with the support of US HUD, NALCAB has operated a national Rural Capacity Building Program designed to provide technical assistance and loans to rural-serving nonprofits and government agencies.

## Community Compass

As a HUD-procured Community Compass technical assistance (TA) provider, NALCAB has engaged in over 100 TA assignments since 2010 to support the equitable and efficient deployment of federal entitlement funding (HOME, CDBG, CARES Act, etc.)

## VISTA Affordable Housing and Preservation Program (VAHPP)

For the past 2 years, NALCAB has served as the national intermediary to place AmeriCorps VISTA volunteers at local nonprofits, to support community and tenant organizing in qualified federally-subsidized multifamily housing properties.

## CDFI Certification Program

NALCAB launched a new initiative to assist Latino-serving small business and affordable housing lenders obtain CDFI certification from the US Dept of Treasury. At no cost to the program participants, NALCAB will assist 30 NALCAB member lenders to submit applications for CDFI certification.

## Advisory Services

With proven expertise in community and economic development, NALCAB provides consulting services in areas such as data analysis/research, GIS mapping, policy analysis, curriculum design, community engagement, impact and evaluation, and training and leadership development.

# Signature Programs



Established in 2010, the Pete Garcia Community Economic Development Fellowship was created to address the growing leadership gap in Latino-serving community development nonprofits. The program offers training for next-generation Latino leaders to build the skills needed to succeed and ascend to executive level positions.



The LEAD Fellowship is NALCAB's new Latino leadership development program designed specifically for CEOs, Executive Directors, and Presidents of economic asset-building nonprofits. Presented in partnership with the Cisneros Hispanic Leadership Institute at The George Washington University (GW) the program focuses on racial and ethnic equity through a Latino-focused lens.



NALCE is a cross-collaborative initiative created to unite and amplify the voices of Latino-led CDFIs and drive capital toward Latino CDFIs to further benefit underserved communities.
