#### **Small Business Development**

We help Latino families and businesses meet their financial goals. NALCAB's network of trusted nonprofits provide financial coaching and access to affordable products that help build savings, credit and generational wealth.

Cracking the Federal Code



NALCAB launched a new initiative to assist Latino-serving small business and affordable housing lenders obtain CDFI certification from the US Dept of Treasury. At no cost to program participants, NALCAB will assist 30 NALCAB member lenders to submit applications for CDFI certification.

NALCAB is a technical assistance (TA) provider for the US Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) **Rural Capacity Building** (RCB) and **Community Compass** programs. Through RCB, NALCAB provides TA and loans to rural-serving nonprofits and government agencies, and through Community Compass NALCAB has engaged in over 100 TA assignments since 2010 to support the equitable deployment of federal entitlement funding for programs such as HOME, CDBG, CARES Act, and others.

Many nonprofits have the expertise to deliver federally-funded programs but not the time or resources to apply. NALCAB's newest program builds the capacity of our members organizations to access these opportunities, especially recently legislated large-scale funding that targets LMI communities.

With proven expertise in community and economic development, NALCAB provides consulting services in areas such as data analysis/research, GIS mapping, policy, curriculum design, community engagement, impact and evaluation, and leadership development.

Established in 2010, the Pete Garcia Community Economic Development Fellowship was created to address the growing leadership gap in Latino-serving community development nonprofits. The program offers training for next-generation Latino leaders to build the skills needed to succeed and ascend to executive level positions.

NALCAB's new LEAD Fellowship is designed specifically for CEOs and, Executive Directors of economic asset-building nonprofits. Presented in partnership with the Cisneros Hispanic Leadership Institute at The George Washington University (GW), the program focuses on racial and ethnic equity through a Latino-focused lens.
